

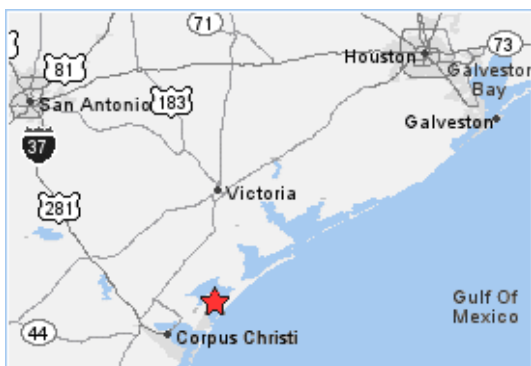

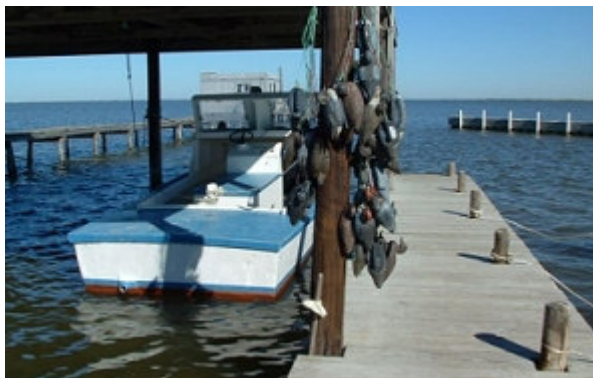


The Port Bay Club is the oldest hunting and fishing club in Texas, started in 1909.

The Port Bay Club lies about four miles southwest of **Rockport**, over a half mile off FM 1069 down the hard surfaced road marked "**Port Bay Club, Historical Marker**".



Port Bay property is the narrow, southernmost "tail" of **Copano Bay**, one of the largest protected inland bays along the Texas Coast, and a legendary fishing and wildlife area. Just north and east of Copano is the famous **Aransas National Wildlife Refuge**.





The Port Bay Club is prominently featured in the book [Texas Tides](#) by Tosh Brown, who writes of "tagging along on the bay with my father" starting around 1972.
